D. Final declaration

- 1. I may only apply for **one** residence title. It is not possible to tick several residence titles or purposes of residence on the first page.
- 2. I have given all the information correctly. I have not intentionally misrepresented anything. I have handed in all the supporting documents that I have. If the authorities want me to, I have to have documents that are not in German translated. Then I must hand in the documents in German.
 - If the document is not written in German or English, however, it makes sense for me to have my documents translated straight away. Then the authorities can work faster.
- 3. I have to give my address. The authority sends all letters to me to this address. If this address changes, I have to notify the authority immediately. For example, if I move house. If the authorities repeatedly fail to deliver a letter to me, they can discontinue the procedure. Then I don't get a residence permit!
 - I can also specify a person authorised to receive service. The authority will then send my letters to this person. For information on what an authorised representative is, see page 2 under Representatives.
 - If any of the information on this form changes, I have to report it to the authorities immediately! I have to do this in writing. I have to send all the important documents.
- 4. I must collect the residence title in person! If I have a legal representative, I must collect the residence permit in person together with the representative. For example, the mother or father can be the legal representative for their child. People with disabilities can also have a legal representative. Children under the age of 14 do not have to come with you to collect the residence permit.
- 5. If I get a residence title according to No. (2), (4), (5), (6), (8), (9) or (10) on page 1, I have to comply with Module 1 of the Integration Agreement. That means I have to learn German.
- 6. If I state something incorrectly or if I don't state everything, I may not get a residence title! It is also possible that the authorities will not renew my residence title. This can also happen if I do not adhere to points 1 to 4 of this final declaration.
- 7. If my **family circumstances change**, I have to report this to the authorities! This could be a divorce, for example. I have to report it no later than one month after the change.
- 8. I am not allowed to marry anyone just to get a residence title! I may not enter into a registered partnership with anyone just to get a residence title! I am not allowed to arrange a marriage or registered partnership with anyone just to get a residence title.
 - I am not allowed to adopt someone just to get a residence permit. No one is allowed to adopt me just so that I can get a residence permit. I am not allowed to arrange an adoption just so that he gets a residence title.

These marriages, registered partnerships and adoptions are punishable! That means I will be charged. I may have to pay a fine or go to prison.

It is also a criminal offence if I give false information in order to get a residence permit!

- 9. If I commit an administrative offence, I have to pay a fine of 50 euros to 250 euros.
 - I have to announce immediately if the purpose of residence changes. I may only do what is part of my purpose of residence.
 - I have to hand in documents that are not or no longer valid to the authorities.
 - I have to report to the authorities immediately if someone has stolen my residence permit, if I have lost it or if the residence permit has become broken. I also have to report immediately if my data changes. For example, if I get married and change my name.
 - If my family circumstances change, I have to report this to the authorities after 1 month at the latest. For example, if I get married or divorced.

I commit an administrative offence if I do not comply with what is written in point 9.

What do you do if you want to extend your residence permit?

Before your residence title expires, you can apply for a new residence title in **person.** You can submit the application for a further residence title

- at the earliest three months before expiry and
- at the latest on the day on which the residence title expires.

The expiry date is written on your residence permit.

If you submit the application too late, the application is considered the first application. This means that you will probably have to leave Austria. You have to file the application abroad.

This is stated in § 24 of the Settlement and Residence Act. The abbreviation for this is NAG.
